

Volentes autem in huius Praesulis locum virum idoneum constituere, de te, Venerabilis Frater, cogitavimus, qui in administratione dioecesis Dindigulensis haud paucis episcopalibus dotibus et virtutibus te praeditum ostendisti. # English Translation of the Papal Bull appointing the Archbishop FRANCIS

#### Bishop, Servant of the Servants of God

To our Venerable Brother Anthony Pappusamy, until now Bishop of Dindigul, and hereby appointed to the Metropolitan Church of Madurai, greetings and Apostolic Blessing.

We realize that, whenever for any reason a particular Church becomes vacant, it is important that the vacancy not be prolonged. For this reason, we wish to assure that the vacancy of the Metropolitan Church of Madhurai not be protracted, since it is now vacant because of the acceptance of the resignation of the former incumbent, Archbishop Peter Fernando.

In his place we wish to appoint an appropriate person, and we know, Venerable Brother, that in your administration of the Diocese of Dindigui you have shown that you possess many qualities and virtues. For this reason, and listening to the advice of the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples, by virtue of our supreme Apostolic authority, and by these letters hereby release you from the bonds attaching you to the Diocese of Dindigui, and appoint you Metropolitan Arxchbishop of Madurai.

You are to inform the clergy and the faithful of your appointment to this ecclesial community, so that they not only willingly receive you, but also love you as a Father and guardian of their souls, and will faithfully obey those precepts which you will issue for their well-being.

Certainly, Venerable Brother, your experience will be your best teacher, but because each flock has various circumstances and needs, it will be important for you to carry out this function prudently, determining whether certain things need to change or to be promoted.

May Christ, the redeemer of the human race and our one Teacher, with the assistance of the Virgin Mary, keep you in his grace and strengthen you through the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Given in Rome, at St. Peter's, this twenty-sixth day of July, in the year two thousand and fourteen, the second year of our Pontificate.

While taking up the pastoral leadership of this Archdiocese remember Dear Bishop Antony the words of Pope Francis addressed to the Bishops of Asia during his recent visit to South Korea. He stated: "We cannot engage in real dialogue unless we are conscious of our own identity. Your Episcopal motto *Servire cum Amore* (Service with love) indeed reflects this mission. As a good shepherd you are called to serve with love all the faithful of this Archdiocese without any discrimination for all are children of God and belong to your flock. As Pope Francis continuously reiterates a good shepherd must have special concern for the poor, the sick, the elderly and the youth.

**Dear Priests of the Archdiocese of Madurai**, as immediate collaborators in the pastoral ministry of Archbishop Antony Pappusamy I urge you to afford him your support, obedience and creativity so that the people entrusted to his care find happiness and solace. In so doing you declare yourselves worthy of the ministry entrusted to you by Christ. I also exhort the Religious men and women to wholeheartedly collaborate with the new Bishop as per your charisms to uplift the spiritual and material life of the people of God in this Archdiocese.

**Dear faithful of Madurai**, it is with great confidence that today I commend to you Archbishop Antony Pappusamy who I know will be the kind of bishop Pope Francis is speaking of. Archbishop Antony is here to serve you in your spiritual needs, welcome him in your midst with love, listen to him attentively and follow his instructions with religious obedience and enthusiasm. And let us pray for him and for his ministry in the years ahead, that it will be fruitful in ways that are beyond all your expectations.
